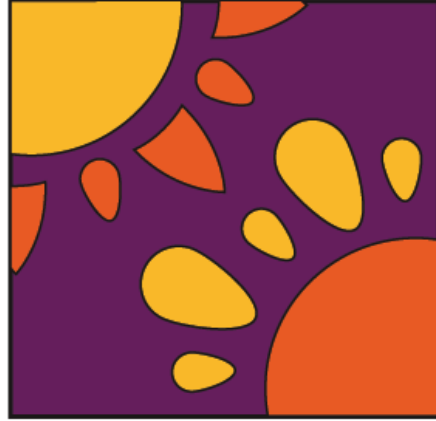

Organizations Annual Budget	Fee
Below \$250,000	\$250
From \$250,000 to \$750,000	\$500
From \$750,000 to \$3 million	\$750
Above \$3 million	\$1,000

- **LEADERSHIP MEMBER: \$5,000**

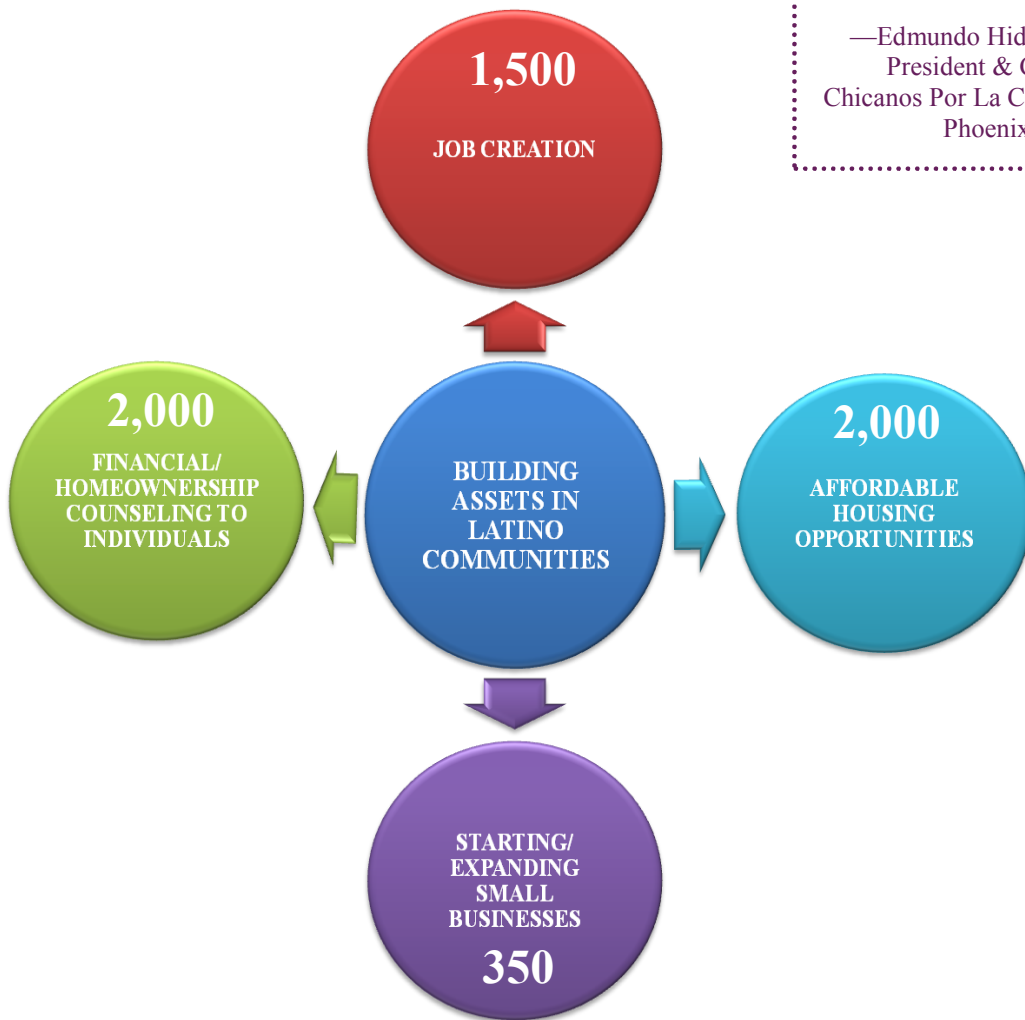

Over the past two years, NALCAB has provided direct technical assistance to more than **45** organizations in **26** states and the District of Columbia and secured approximately **\$165 million** in federal funding for member organizations that will achieve the following impacts:
